

Roystonea Avenue duplication

Temporary closure of Buscall Avenue

Dear Stakeholder

The Department of Logistics and Infrastructure (DLI) is duplicating Roystonea Avenue Palmerston, from Terry Drive to Lambrick Avenue. These works will improve road safety for all road users, future traffic flow and drainage.

Some delays to traffic flow may be expected from time-to-time. The department appreciates your patience and flexibility during the construction works.

Buscall Avenue temporary closure

As part of the project, an upgraded intersection with dedicated turning lanes will be installed at the Buscall Avenue and Roystonea Avenue intersection.

To ensure the safety of construction crew and road users, Buscall Avenue will be temporarily closed between Roystonea Avenue and Lakeview Boulevard from 5 August 2026 for approximately 15 weeks (weather permitting).

Vehicles are encouraged to detour via Forrest Parade, Chung Wah Terrace side of Buscall Avenue, or Lambrick Drive.

Pedestrian access will be maintained while local traffic will need to detour along Terry Drive or Lambrick Avenue during this time.

Terry Drive changed access

As part of the changed traffic conditions, local traffic will be permitted to turn left and right from Roystonea Avenue onto Terry Drive.

Vehicles are also able to turn left from Terry Drive onto Roystonea Avenue. There will be no right turn from Terry Drive onto Roystonea Avenue.

These changes will be in place from 5 August 2026 for approximately 15 weeks (weather permitting).

Inverway Circuit changed access

As part of the changed traffic conditions, vehicles will be permitted to turn left and right from Inverway Circuit onto Roystonea Avenue.

Vehicles are also able to turn left from Roystonea Avenue onto Inverway Circuit but there will be no right turn from Roystonea Avenue onto Inverway Circuit. Alternate access is via Temple Terrace or Lambrick Avenue.

These changes will be in place from 5 August 2026 for approximately 15 weeks (weather permitting).

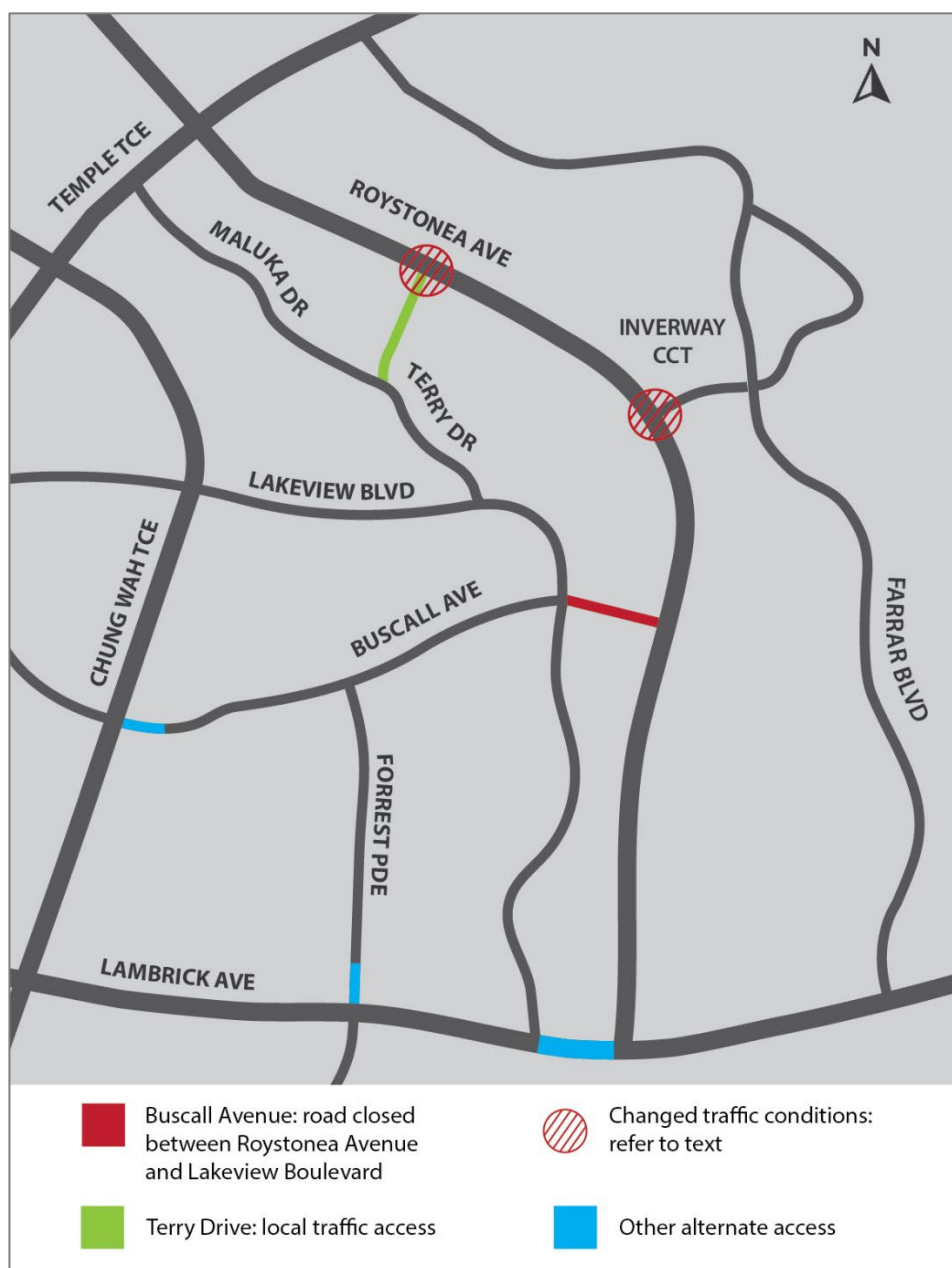


Image showing location of changed traffic conditions for Buscall Avenue
