

Variable message boards (VMB) at boat ramps

The Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics (DIPL) is installing variable message boards (VMB) at various Darwin boat ramps.

VMBs have been installed in a staged approach at East Arm and Elizabeth River boat ramps, and work will continue within the next month to install a VMB at Dinah Beach boat ramp. This is expected to be completed in April 2024.

The VMBs will:

- promote important marine public safety messaging in a timely manner and encourage boat users to act responsibly while on the water and have the correct boat safety equipment
- inform boat users about upcoming changes to access/exclusion zones/hazards during projects under construction in Darwin Harbour, special events and weather impacts.

Boat ramp users are asked to adhere to all traffic management and signage in the area during installation.
