

Schwarz Crescent safety improvements

Preparatory works commencing

The Department of Logistics and Infrastructure is planning for future upgrades at the Schwarz Crescent and Stuart Highway intersection with preparatory works commencing in April 2025.

The scope of preparatory works include:

- relocation of underground communication service (Telstra and NBN) along Stuart Highway and Schwarz Crescent alignments.

Works will commence on Friday 11 April and are expected to be completed by Monday 26 May 2025.

These works will be undertaken between 8am and 4pm, Monday to Friday.

Any short-term loss of connectivity to businesses will be communicated via the contractor. Schwarz Crescent and Stuart Highway will remain open with traffic management in place throughout.

Please adhere to all traffic management and safety measures in place.

The \$10.8 million future intersection upgrade, funded by the Australian Government and Northern Territory Government, will improve safety for vehicles and pedestrians. Future upgrades will include:

- Realignment of the existing Schwarz Crescent further north to create a new four-way, signalised intersection with the existing Smith Street/Stuart Highway intersection.
- Inclusion of safe pedestrian crossings in all directions at the new traffic lights.
- Closure of the existing section of Schwarz Crescent adjacent to the Stuart Highway.

The project is progressing through the planning stages as the department continues to work with associated parties to finalise these matters.
