

Chung Wah Terrace and Emery Avenue roundabout

Construction works

Dear Stakeholder

The Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics (DIPL) is conducting works for the construction of a new roundabout at the intersection of Chung Wah Terrace and Emery Avenue, Palmerston.

A roundabout will improve safety at the intersection, which has been the site of 35 traffic incidents since 2018, resulting in 21 injuries.

Construction is expected to start in March 2024 and it is anticipated to take 6 months to complete. Works will be undertaken while allowing traffic to flow under traffic management conditions.

Work Monday to Saturday, temporary lane closures and reduced speed conditions can be expected. Night works will be required at times, with residents notified in advance.

Engineering studies recommend the construction of a roundabout at the intersection of Chung Wah Terrace and Emery Avenue to reduce the risk of further crashes and effectively manage traffic flow.
