

Tiger Brennan Drive and Berrimah Road overpass project

Project update – access to East Arm

The Department of Logistics and Infrastructure is continuing to reconnect traffic to Berrimah Road as part of the Tiger Brennan Drive and Berrimah Road overpass (TBOP) project.

Access to Berrimah Road south (East Arm) is anticipated to be restored on **Wednesday 16 April**.

Following the opening of the new overpass, nearby signalised intersections will be monitored and adjusted as required to optimise traffic flow and safety. As this section of Berrimah Road has been closed for an extended period, it may take some time for traffic patterns to adjust and stabilise.

Full completion of the project is anticipated in May 2025. The final works include:

- shared user paths
- final landscaping
- emergency services access into the Hidden Valley motorsports complex.

Every effort has been made to limit construction time and disruptions, while ensuring improved safety for road users and construction workers.
