Place name	Origin of name
Aherrenge Road	Named after the Aherrenge (kangaroo) dreaming that is very important to Ampilatwatja
Airport Road	Road leading to the airport
Luck Street	Named after Johno Luck whose family was originally from Irrultja
Main Road	Main road in the community
Middle Street	Street in the middle of the community
Morton Street	Named after Frank Morton
School Road	Road where the school is situated
South Street	Street at the southern end of the community
