

Central Arnhem Road Upgrades Tender release - Stuart Highway to Tandangle Hill

Dear Stakeholder

The Northern Territory Government is delivering long term upgrades on Central Arnhem Road.

A design and construction tender to upgrade 46.6 kilometres from the Stuart Highway to Tandangle Hill (from chainage 0km to 46.6km) has been released via [Tenders Online](#). The tender period will close on Wednesday 7 May 2025, with construction works expected to start in late 2025.

The upgrades will deliver a dual-lane seal with flood immunity improvements. This will improve connectivity, travel time, road safety and accessibility.

These works form part of the program to upgrade priority sections of Central Arnhem Road. \$355 million has been committed to deliver upgrades, including \$280 million from the Australian Government and \$75 million from the Northern Territory Government.

Three sections of road, totaling more than 24 kms near Beswick, the Goyder approaches and Bulman Airfield, have already been completed under the Central Arnhem Road Upgrades. The contract for construction of 18kms near Mountain Valley Station (from Ch158 km to Ch176 km) has been awarded and is expected to start in April 2025.
