

# Tiger Brennan Drive and Berrimah Road Overpass project

## Project update: inbound on-ramp opening

The Department of Logistics and Infrastructure is continuing to reconnect traffic to Berrimah Road as part of the Tiger Brennan Drive and Berrimah Road Overpass (TBOP) project.

The next phase of the TBOP project will open the right turn from Berrimah Road north onto the Tiger Brennan Drive on-ramp, for Darwin-bound traffic. The temporary traffic management currently in place will be removed to allow this turn.

These works are expected to be completed, and the ramp open to traffic, by Saturday 29 March.

Access to/from Berrimah Road south (East Arm), along with the Darwin-bound off-ramp from Tiger Brennan Drive onto Berrimah Road, is expected to be restored by the end of April. This will provide access to both Berrimah Road north and East Arm for Darwin-bound traffic.

Every effort has been made to limit construction time and disruptions, while ensuring improved safety for road users and construction workers.

Please adhere to all traffic management and safety measures in place.
