

Arnhem Highway – Adelaide River Floodplain Upgrade

Works commencing on eastern and western matching in areas

Dear Stakeholder,

The Australian and Northern Territory Governments are funding a major upgrade of the Arnhem Highway across the Adelaide River Floodplain.

The upgrade project will reduce road closures during the wet season along the Arnhem Highway due to flooding of the Adelaide River floodplain by raising the road level and improving under road drainage.

Within the next fortnight, works will commence on the eastern and western matching in areas.

Traffic management will be in place at the western matching in area for approximately two weeks where one lane will be operational for both inbound and outbound traffic.

On the eastern matching in area traffic will be managed via a detour allowing 2-way traffic flow. This will be in place for approximately four weeks.

Motorists are advised to adhere to all traffic management controls. After hours arrangements will be in place over nights and weekends when works are not occurring.

Works on these matching in areas of the Arnhem Highway is estimated to be complete by late October, weather permitting.

The project team greatly appreciates road users understanding and co-operation during construction enabling this key strategic project to improve access, safety and efficiencies into the future.
