

## Richardson Park Access to Ludmilla Primary School via Richardson Drive

Dear Stakeholder,

The Northern Territory Government continues to deliver improvements to Richardson Park to reactivate the community space with access to Ludmilla School via Richardson Drive now completed.

This component of the revitalisation will provide an alternate access point to Ludmilla Primary School for the community.

The extension will allow parents and caregivers to safely “Kiss and Go” or park their vehicle for a short period of time to drop and collect their children from the school.

Access to Ludmilla Primary School via Richardson Drive is for vehicles only. Pedestrian access will remain via Bagot Road and the Ludmilla Terrace and Namarluk Drive laneways until construction works are complete.

A period of establishment for the final landscaping areas in Richardson Park will be in place until July, with the opening of the community component of the facility, including the main and secondary playing fields to follow.

The next package of works includes building the ablutions block, change rooms, storage and associated undercover areas, and exercise and playground equipment. The tender for this package of works is currently under assessment and is anticipated to be awarded in May with completion expected late 2024.

The memorial for Warren ‘Shadow’ Mount has been preserved and reinstated in a prominent position on the grounds, acknowledging the site’s history and the lengthy connection Rugby League has had with Richardson Park.

The new public open space features covered picnic shelters with 340 new trees and shrubs planted to provide shaded areas throughout the site.

Asbestos remediation site based activities have been completed.
