NAMING OF PLACES

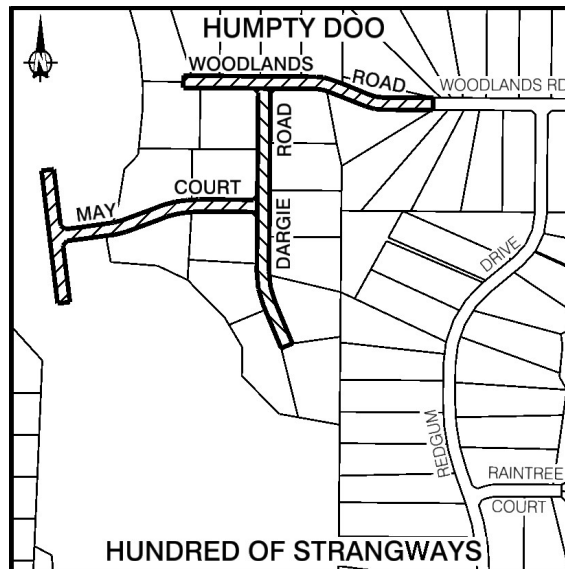
I, Gerald Francis McCarthy, Minister for Lands and Planning:

- (a) under section 11(1)(a) of the *Place Names Act* and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, revoke the instrument naming Dargie Road dated 31 October 1996 and published in *Gazette* No. G47 of 20 November 1996; and
- (b) under section 11(1)(a) of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report by the Place Names Committee that the roads shown hatched on the plan in the Schedule be named Dargie Road, May Court and Woodlands Road as specified on the plan.

NOTES:

Dargie Road is named in commemoration of Charles and Emily Dargie (1864-1929 and 1874-1955 respectively), early Daly River farmers.

May Court is named in commemoration of Arthur John May (-2007), a surveyor who worked in the Territory for 30 years.

Woodlands Road is named after the original estate named for the subdivision.
