Chan Building Demolition

Dear stakeholder,

The Northern Territory Government last month awarded a contract to McMahon Services Australia (NT) to demolish the Chan Building.

The demolition forms part of a larger set of works to realise the redevelopment of the Civic and State Square masterplan. The site will be remediated and Territorians will benefit from the works in the short term with further public open space being provided which will help realise the masterplan vision for Civic and State Square.

Preparation works will start this month ahead of the demolition works, which are currently scheduled to start in May 2020.

To enable the preparation works to take place, the car spaces shown below in the carpark immediately adjacent to the Chan Building will be closed off from 5pm Thursday 9 April 2020 and from then onwards will not be available for parking.

This closure will be in place permanently and the area will be converted into green open public spaces. Car parking capacity is available in the nearby underground carpark.
