TIGER BRENNAN DRIVE AND BERRIMAH ROAD OVERPASS

The Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics is building an overpass at the Tiger Brennan Drive and Berrimah Road intersection.

The project is jointly funded by the Australian and Northern Territory governments.

The new overpass will carry Berrimah Road traffic over Tiger Brennan Drive, separating the major flow of traffic on Tiger Brennan Drive from the traffic movements on Berrimah Road enabling continuous flow and improved safety.

Construction on the Tiger Brennan Drive and Berrimah Road overpass is being rolled out in phases.

Some preparatory site works took place in 2022 and early 2023. The next phase of the project including the bridge construction is due to















Road closure and detours

In order to construct the new bridge, from 10 March 2023 Berrimah Road from Marlow Road to Tiger Brennan Drive will be closed to all road users.

Tiger Brennan Drive will remain open and vehicles travelling between Darwin and Palmerston can continue to travel along Tiger Brennan Drive and access East Arm as normal.

Road users have a number of alternative routes to access Berrimah north of the existing Tiger Brennan Drive via Stuart Highway including use of:

- » Tivendale Road
- » Hidden Valley Road
- » Amy Johnson Avenue.

The first phase of works is the most extensive. New lanes will be constructed for Tiger Brennan Drive and the Berrimah Road overpass bridge constructed.

Consideration has been given to minimise impact for heavy and emergency vehicles as well as the general travelling public and local businesses.

It is expected this stage of the project will take between 9-12 months to complete.
