

McMillans Road, Northlakes Pedestrian crossing update

Dear Stakeholder

The Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics (DIPL) has recently completed works to install a new pedestrian crossing on McMillans Road near the Matthews Road intersection.

Night works for the commissioning of the new pedestrian signals will commence on Tuesday 30 April 2024 and the new signalised crossing will be active by Wednesday 1 May 2024.

The new pedestrian crossing will improve road safety for all road users, including pedestrians and cyclists, by incorporating a signalised pedestrian crossing and a footpath.


The pedestrian crossing will also see improved accessibility to and from the bus stop on McMillans Road and the Northlakes Shopping Centre.

Road users, pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take caution during these works and adhere to the traffic management in place.
