The Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics is undertaking asphalt works on the Darwin inbound lanes of Tiger Brennan Drive, as part of the Tiger Brennan Drive and Berrimah Road Overpass project.

A full closure of the Tiger Brennan Drive, Palmerston to Darwin inbound lanes from the Stuart Highway/Roystonea Avenue/Tiger Brennan Drive interchange to Amy Johnson Avenue, is planned from 6:00pm Friday 16 August, reopening 6:00am Monday 19 August 2024.

Works will include the final tie-in of the new Tiger Brennan Drive inbound lanes and the decommissioning of the side track/detour currently being used by Darwin-bound traffic.

Traffic management planning has identified that suitable alternative routes are available for all impacted movements via Amy Johnston Avenue, Stuart Highway and Tivendale Road.

The Darwin to Palmerston outbound lanes will remain open at all times.

Every effort has been made to limit construction time and disruptions, while ensuring improved safety for road users and construction workers.

Road users are advised to follow all traffic management in place.
