Alice Springs CBD Revitalisation Project Project update

Dear Stakeholder,

As Alice Springs CBD Revitalisation works progress, the Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics wishes to advise Asbestos Containing Material (ACM) has been identified within the work site.

An asbestos investigation has taken place and remediation works are underway.

Remediation works are being completed in accordance with all applicable regulations and Australian Standards and in liaison with NT WorkSafe.

An independent hygienist has been engaged to monitor and regulate these works and will conduct air monitoring.

The remediation sees planned completion dates amended.

Stage 1 completion is now scheduled for late-November

Coles side of Bath St will be closed:

• Between Gregory Tce and Parsons St (north bound)

Stage 2 late-November to mid-December

Yeperenye Shopping Centre side of Bath Street will have intermittent road, and footpath, closures with traffic management in place and safe designated pedestrian crossing between the Woolworths and Coles shopping centers, where possible:

• Between Gregory Tce and Parsons St (south bound)

The site will close for the Christmas period from mid-December. Works will recommence on Hartley Street and the shade structures are expected to be installed early in the New Year.
