

Stakeholder notice – Nightcliff Jetty upgrade works extended

Nightcliff Jetty upgrade works extended

Dear stakeholder,

The Department of Logistics and Infrastructure advises that upgrade works at Nightcliff Jetty will continue beyond the previously anticipated completion date following the identification of additional required structural repairs.

Works commenced on 11 May 2026 and were anticipated to be completed in late July 2026. Further inspections have identified the need for more extensive repairs to existing steel beams, girders and pylons. These additional works are necessary to improve the structural integrity of the jetty and ensure it remains safe for all users into the future.

As a result, Nightcliff Jetty will remain closed to the public, with construction now expected to be completed in November 2026.

Temporary public access arrangements will not be available during the Term 3 school holiday period, allowing works to continue uninterrupted and supporting the timely completion of the upgrades. Every effort is being made to reopen the jetty as soon as it is safe to do so.

The car park and surrounding foreshore areas will continue to remain open and traffic management measures may be required from time to time. Pedestrians and motorists are asked to exercise caution and follow all signage and directions from onsite personnel.

DLI is committed to completing the essential repairs and upgrades as efficiently as possible and appreciates the community's patience and understanding while the improvements are undertaken.

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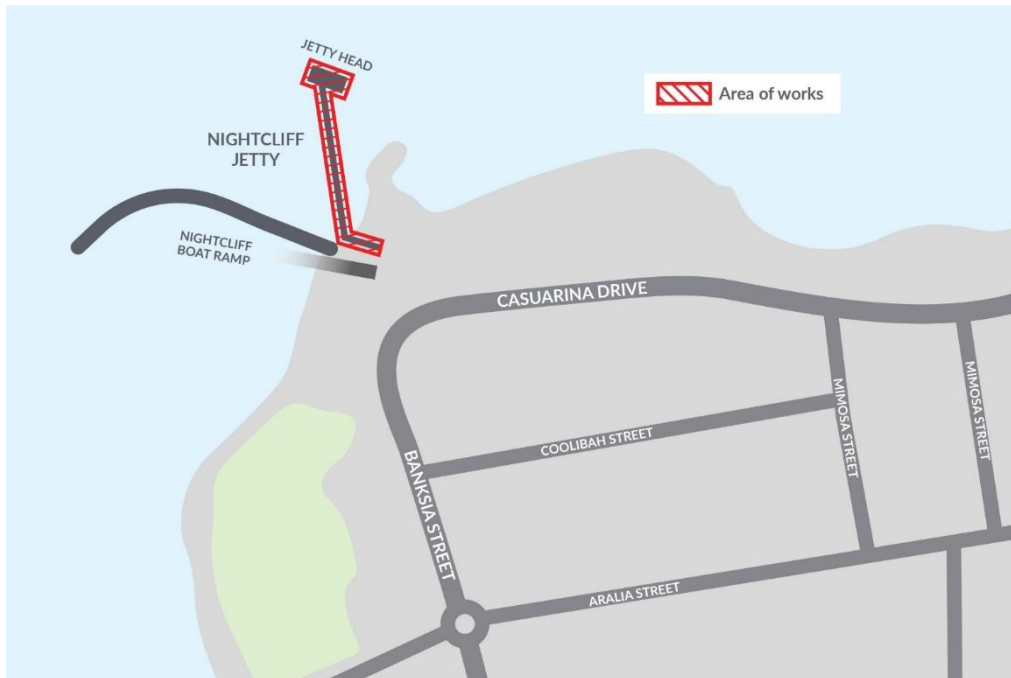


Image shows area of works on Nightcliff Jetty.
