

Dundee Beach boat ramp upgrade

Groyne upgrade – walkway jetty

The Department of Logistics and Infrastructure is undertaking improvement works at the Dundee Beach boat ramp facility.

As part of these works, the new walkway jetty alongside the boat ramp will be complete and open for use by the general public for the Easter weekend.

The new jetty structure will allow boat owners to load and unload passengers and fishing gear 'on the water', improving access and reducing delays with launch and retrieval activities on the ramp.

Jetty users are encouraged to exercise discretion, move off the jetty as quickly as possible, and avoid long-term, unattended mooring of boats.

Work on the groyne, including the new fishing platform, will be ongoing for several more weeks and the groyne will not be accessible.

Groyne upgrade works will:

- allow for land-based fishing via a walkway jetty and platform along the top of the groyne
- provide improved access to the groyne
- help reduce the rate of sand build-up on the ramp, reducing the frequency of maintenance, to maximise future ramp access for users.
