

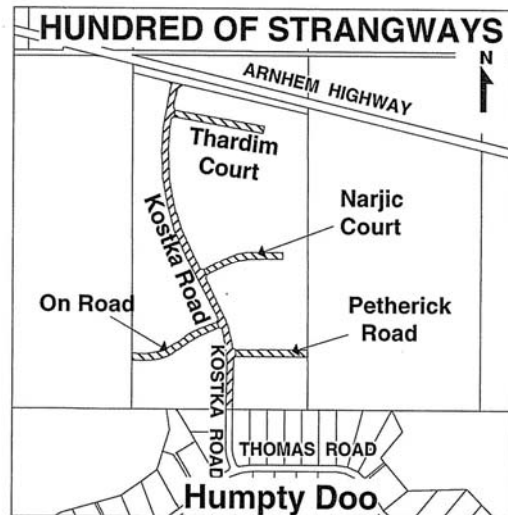
Place Names Act

NAMING OF PLACE

I, DELIA PHOEBE LAWRIE, the Minister for Planning and Lands, in pursuance of section 11 of the *Place Names Act*, approve the recommendation contained in a report by the Place Names Committee that the roads shown hatched on the plan appearing in the schedule be named Kostka Road, Petherick Road, On Road, Thardim Court and Narjic Court as indicated on that plan.

NOTE:

Kostka Road

is named in commemoration of Jaromir Jan (Gerry) Kostka (1924-1999), miner and accountant, who emigrated from Czechoslovakia in 1950, arriving in the Territory in 1953, and was the unofficial Czech ambassador in Darwin.

Petherick Road

is named in commemoration of Rosie Nangalaku Petherick (1925–2007) an Aboriginal woman, born on the Moyle River, who in 1949 met Ray Petherick and together worked timber and crocodiles in the Reynolds and Finniss River wetlands. They had eight children.

On Road

is named in commemoration of Charlie On (1941-1994) businessman, pastoralist and property developer, long time Humpty Doo resident establishing an early mango orchard.

Thardim Court

is named in commemoration of Tarcisius Thardim (1938-1996) a Marringarr Aboriginal man, who in his teenage years worked on Legune, Meneling and Auvergne Stations before returning to Wadeye to work as a carpenter. and

Narjic Court

is named in commemoration of Therese Karingari Narjic (1939-1996) an Aboriginal woman, who worked at Auvergne Station before returning to Wadeye to work in the museum.
